Retail bar codes can be applied quickly, easily and safely to individual pieces of timber, using the *Fas Tagger II*® stapling tool.



The Weber Fas Tagger II is an automatic tagging tool that dispenses Poly Tags and staples them securely in place – all in one step.

The Fas Tagger II uses compressed air to apply tags at a rate of over 100 per minute. The operator places the tool against the piece of timber and pulls the trigger. The Fas Tagger II automatically staples the tag to the timber, cuts it, and feeds the next tag into position.

Because it accepts a range of poly tag sizes, the Fas Tagger II is versatile enough to handle a full range of bar code and product identification needs.

The Fas Tagger II is easy to use – at 2.5 Kgs, it is light enough to hold in one hand, yet durable enough to withstand the working environments of timber processors.

Two different lengths and widths of tag are available. The unit has a quick-change facility so that you can change the tag size in less than 10 seconds.

The Fas Tagger performs best when using the manufacturer's specially-designed Poly Tags. This material easily accepts thermal transfer printing, and is designed to resist fading and abrasion caused by outside storage and handling in mill or DIY centre environments.
